**Re: Transervice Collective Agreement**

Further to my Memo dated October 22, 2007.

Item 12 of the Transervice Memorandum states:

"The Agreement will be revised, by mutual consent, to reflect appropriate and proper conditions for the Business and Fleet Service Operations".

For clarity, I am reviewing a Transervice Collective Agreement, as it would exist today i.e. extracting the Bell contract language that applies to the Mechanics in conjunction with the ratified Memorandum changes. This process does not negate item 12 above.

There will be an election of Transervice delegate(s) at the upcoming OCC that will then meet with the Employer to review, modify and/or streamline the language - e.g. 912 process, as well as to ensure that all applicable language is transferred from the Bell Collective Agreement. Once this process has been complete the revised Collective Agreement pertaining to Transervice members only will be printed and distributed.
