## 2011 NEGOTIATIONS WITH EXPERTECH FOR CEP CRAFT & SERVICES MEMBERS

February 10, 2012

Brothers and Sisters,

Your bargaining committee and the company will meet on Monday, February 13<sup>th</sup> and have booked that week to continue bargaining in an attempt to reach an acceptable collective agreement. Your resolve and commitment expressed by the 92% rejection of the company offer has given us the support needed at the bargaining table. We ask that you continue supporting your bargaining committee at this critical time.

Your bargaining committee met on Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> and established our bargaining strategy and we are prepared to meet the company on your behalf.

As you are aware, managers have now commenced asking craft and services members to turn in their keys and computers at the end of their shifts, these are the property of the company and they are within their right to do so.

We would ask that you remove any personal items from your vehicles and work locations.

We have not yet given the 72-hour notice of strike, therefore, we are not in a legal position to strike.

As always, we ask you not to circulate rumours and to stand by for our next communication. Should you have any questions please contact your local executive.
