Sisters and Brothers,

On Thursday, November 29<sup>th</sup> the Bargaining Committee reached a tentative agreement with Bell Canada on a new collective agreement for Craft and Services employees.

The Bargaining Committee is recommending acceptance of the tentative agreement.

Details of the agreement will be reviewed with local union representatives at a bargaining caucus in Ottawa on Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup>.

Ratification meetings in locals across Ontario and Quebec will take place between December 11<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. The full schedule of meeting dates will be communicated shortly.

Ballots will be counted, and the results of the vote will be announced on Friday, December 21<sup>st</sup>.
